



Confirmation Class Mentor Job Description

Purpose: The Confirmation Class Mentor will journey with the Confirmand as they explore their faith through the Confirmation class, providing a positive and faith sharing partner for the course of the class.

Meetings: The Confirmation Class Mentor is expected to attend all meetings and retreats laid out in the Confirmation Class schedule. For a copy of the schedule, please contact Mark Hutton, Director of Spiritual Growth.

Commitment: A commitment for the entire duration of the Confirmation Class is required. On average this is a ten hour per month commitment.

Responsibilities: The Confirmation Class Mentor's responsibilities are to:

- A. work with the Confirmand in one on one and class settings;
- B. develop a positive, faith based relationship with the Confirmand;
- C. be a positive Christian role model;
- D. share your faith and experiences;
- E. communicate with the Confirmand's parent(s), keeping them informed of one on one meeting times and when necessary and appropriate, sharing with them appropriate faith issues;
- F. keep up on monthly assignments, exploring the lessons and wonders of the Christian faith;
- G. be trained in the PCOC policy for the Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse
